Hades



When brothers Hades, Poseidon, and Zeus divided the cosmos to rule, Hades became king of the underworld. He was god of the dead and ruler of everything under the earth, including gems and gold. He's commonly associated with symbols like his two-headed spear, dogs, keys, mint, and pomegranates.

Hades was the oldest son of Cronus and Rhea's six children. Unlike most Greek deities, he was largely faithful to his wife Persephone, goddess of spring. He fathered only a couple obscure children. His three-headed dog Cerberus is much more
